Volunteer Requirements

High school education, completion of all training sessions, commitment to tutoring a student for a year. Meetings will be scheduled at mutually convenient times between you and the student. Meetings with your student may take place in public buildings such as libraries, churches, schools, etc., many of which have reasonably private meeting rooms or areas that can be used for tutoring sessions. The MLK Center is available for tutoring during regular hours.

Preparation time for each tutoring session, attendance at various LVA functions and communication with the LVA office are features of the commitment a tutor makes in addition to tutoring a student. Please consider these commitments carefully before registering for tutor training.

Certification

Volunteers who complete this training program will be pinned as Certified Tutors by Literacy Volunteers Association Cape-Atlantic, Inc. This will enable the volunteer to tutor in this program with the support of the local affiliate or with any affiliate of ProLiteracy America, Inc. throughout New Jersey and nationwide.
